General Information and registration

All three events are conference championship events. The points awarded are double those of a regular collegiate race. Conference medals will be awarded in each race. The entry fee for all three events is \$30. The per-rider entry fee for individual events is \$13. Teams are strongly encouraged to enter their riders by sending an e-mail message to gary.achterberg@mwsu.edu prior to 4 p.m. on Friday, April 25. You will receive a reply by e-mail confirming that your registration was received. Please provide names, collegiate categories, T-shirt size and the season-long race number for each rider. **The entire team must register in one e-mail message.** If entry is made by e-mail, releases may be signed and payment may be made up to a half hour prior to the start of the first road race. Alternately, riders may register in the student center at Midwestern State University (3410 Taft Blvd; Wichita Falls TX 76308) between 6 and 8 p.m. on Friday evening, April 25. **There will be no race-day registration. You must pre-register by e-mail or register in person on Friday evening.**

Event 1: Road Race (Saturday morning)

The road race will take place on a new 15-kilometer (9.4-mile) course. The roads are in excellent condition and the loop is slightly rolling. The course is west of Wichita Falls and a 21-mile drive from the MSU campus. Make sure to allow adequate time to get to the road race course. See DIRECTIONS at the end of this flyer. The Men's Cat. B and Women's Cat. A fields will start together and will be permitted to mix. The Women's Cat. B and high school fields will start together and be permitted to mix. Men's Cat. C will start separately. Follow vehicles will be provided. Wheels in, wheels out. Feed zone will be designated and will be near the starting line. The centerline rule will be enforced.

Event 2: Team Time Trial (Saturday afternoon)

The team time trial will be 20 kilometers (12.4 miles). The out-and-back course is on excellent pavement and has some rolling hills. A start list will be posted at the road race on Saturday morning. The first team will go off at 4:00 p.m. Teams will be started at two-minute intervals. See DIRECTIONS at the end of this race flyer for information on finding the course. Do not warm up or cool down on the race course. Results from both the road race and time trial will be posted at the criterium on Sunday morning. Results will not be available at the time trial. The finish time will be based on the second finisher on each team for women and high school and the third finisher for men. Teams must start with at least that many riders. Both numbers must be worn for the time trial.

Event 3: MSU Campus Criterium (Sunday morning)

The criterium will be held on a rectangular course on the MSU campus. All roads are freshly paved. Free lap rule is in effect. Wheels in, wheels out. The Men's Cat. B and Women's Cat. A fields will start together and will be permitted to mix. Riders who are out of contention may be asked to withdraw. There will be points primes in the collegiate races, as outlined in the collegiate rules. There also will be merchandise primes.

DIRECTIONS TO ALL EVENTS

SATURDAY MORNING ROAD RACE: Go west out of Wichita Falls on the Kell West Freeway, which also is marked as Highway 82 West/Highway 277 South, for approximately seven miles. Turn right onto Highway 258. (There is a Shell gas station at this intersection.) Just after turning, you will see a sign that says “Kamay, 10 miles.” Take this road for 11 miles to Kadane Corner. Turn left onto Highway 25. In a half mile, turn right onto FM1180 West and proceed about 2.5 miles to parking.

SATURDAY AFTERNOON TIME TRIAL: Go west out of Wichita Falls on the Kell West Freeway, which also is marked as Highway 82 West/Highway 277 South, for approximately seven miles. Turn right onto Highway 258. (There is a Shell gas station at this intersection.) Just after turning, you will see a sign that says “Kamay, 10 miles.” After 3-1/2 miles on this road, turn right onto Highway 368 North (toward Iowa Park.) Stay on Highway 368 North for 3 miles. Just after the intersection with FM1206, parking will be available in Burnet Park. Please park there and warm up on Highway 368. The start of the team time trial will be on Highway 367, approximately one mile north of the parking area. Do not park on the roads.

SUNDAY CRITERIUM: The criteriums will take place on the MSU campus. Park in the large lot across from the Ligon Hall Coliseum on the south end of the campus or the large lot in front of the library. The school’s address is 3410 Taft Blvd.; Wichita Falls TX 76308.
